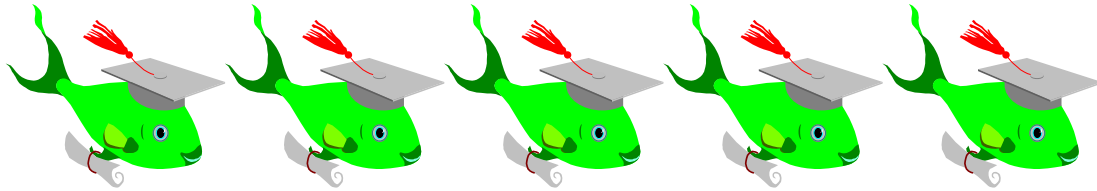


# SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO CHATHAM COUNTY CHILD CARE PROVIDERS

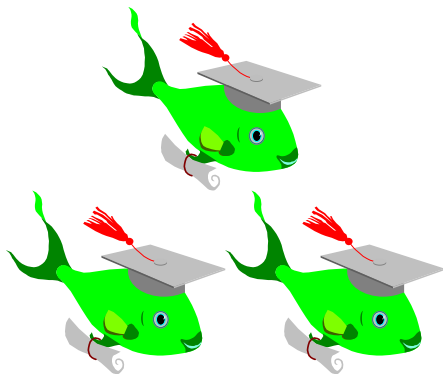


If you work with children ages 0 - 5 in a regulated child care program, you may be eligible for financial help to increase your education.

The T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® Project provides funds to help child care providers take courses in Early Childhood Education. The project provides **financial assistance** with tuition and books, a **travel stipend**, and requires **increased compensation** at the end of the contracted number of credit hours. You may earn a North Carolina Early Childhood Credential or work toward a Certificate, Diploma, or Associate Degree in Early Childhood Education.
